

The Brockville Museum presents

130 Years of Nursing Education

Community Display Case Appeal

To support St. Lawrence College's celebration of 50 years of nursing education at the Brockville campus, the Brockville Museum is putting together an exhibit on the history of nursing education in Brockville, which will run May 5-September 29, 2023 in the museum's lobby. The exhibit will trace the history of nursing education in Brockville back to the first nursing graduate, Isabel Thomas, in 1893 from Brockville General Hospital's school of nursing. The museum's collection includes a considerable assortment of objects representing nursing education in Brockville before 1973, but lacks material from the last 50 years, when training nurses was the responsibility of Ontario Colleges. The museum is putting out the call for loans of small items related to nursing education at Brockville's St. Lawrence College campus for the purposes of this temporary exhibit.

Terms:

- This is an appeal for loans only; potential donations will be considered separately and are subject to the museum's Collection Policy
- Items must relate specifically to the Brockville campus of St. Lawrence College
- Items must occupy a space smaller than one cubic foot
- The lender may offer more than one item
- The lender must complete a loan form to accompany their item(s)
- The lender is responsible for providing a max. 400 character description/summary of the relevance of each item to accompany the item(s) on display; subject to editing by museum staff
- The loan period will be April 11-October 6, 2023
 - Items must be dropped off with accompanying documentation at the museum (5 Henry Street, Brockville) between April 11 and 14 between 10am and 4pm.
 - Items must be picked up at the museum between October 3 and 6 between 10am and 4pm; items not collected by 4pm on October 6, 2023 (without alternative arrangements being made with museum staff) will be considered abandoned and become property of the Brockville Museum and be subject to disposal.
- Museums staff will select which items will be included in the display; items not selected will be returned to the lender on or before May 4, 2023; items not collected by 4pm on May 4, 2023 (without alternative arrangements being made with museum staff) will be considered abandoned and become property of the Brockville Museum and be subject to disposal.
- The Brockville Museum will care for loaned items as described in the museum's Collection Policy
